Road trips are back again, because traveling in the security of your own car and visiting friendly small town America brings back the way America used to be and the way we would like it to be again.

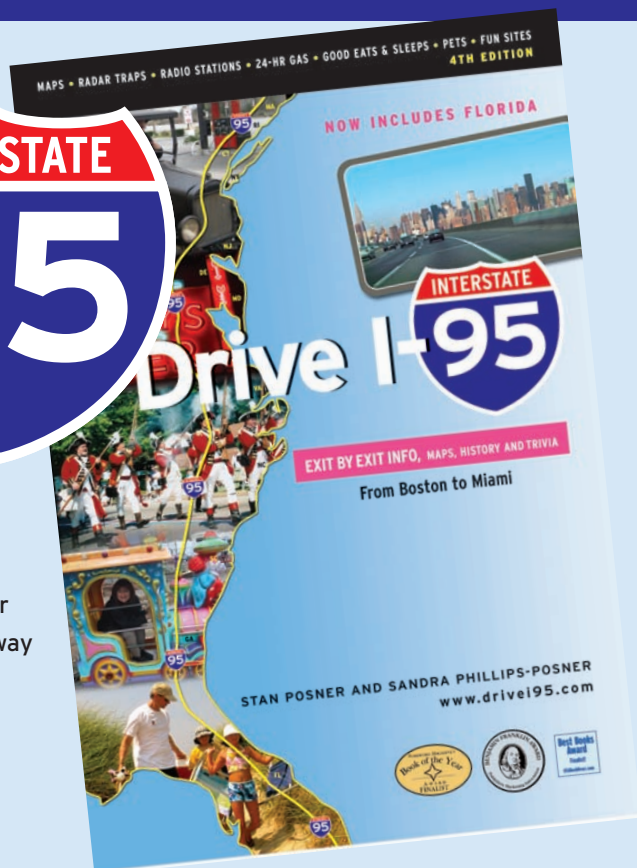
Drive I-95 is a new style of map/guidebook with 30 mile easy-to-follow pictorial maps and stories of the road:

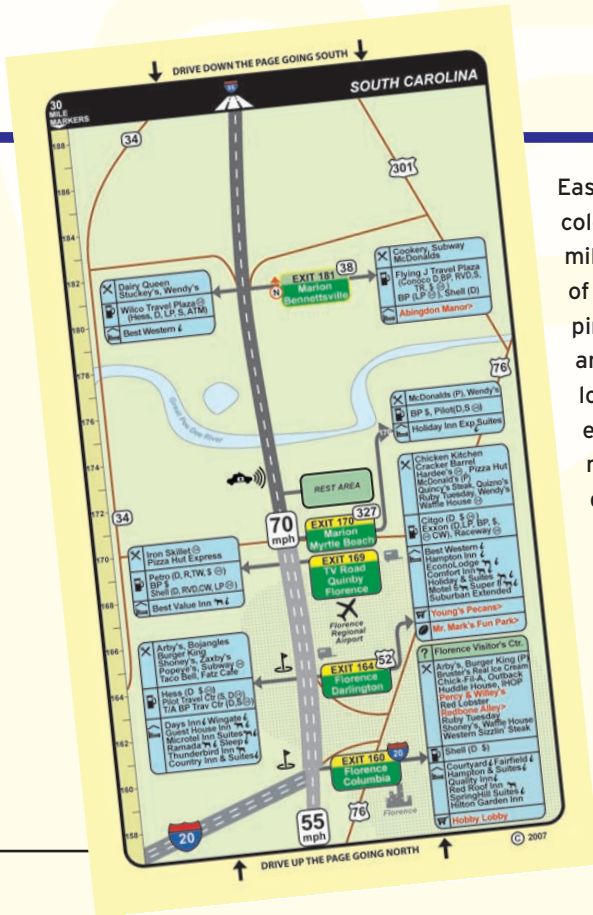
